

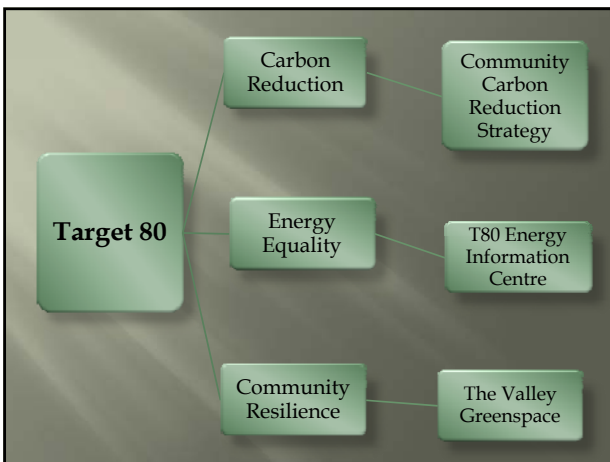

The Valley Greenspace established 2007





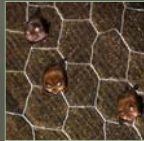


- Provided comprehensive information service
