<b>Renewable Energy Essentials</b> – one-day course on household and community-scale renewable energy systems.
<b>Energy Champions</b> - half-day course focusing on how Energy Champions can reduce energy use at work and motivate other staff.
<b>Energy Awareness at Work</b> - two-hour course that looks at simple actions all staff can take to reduce energy use.
<b>Energy Awareness at Home</b> - half-day course on domestic energy efficiency and methods of treating heat loss and damp, with a basic overview of renewable technology.
<b>Energy Awareness for Tenants</b> - one-day course on energy efficiency at home, reducing fuel bills and addressing climate change.
<b>Home Energy Advisor</b> - half-day course to help energy advisers making home visits. Effective provision of face-to-face energy advice, preparing and planning home energy visits, avoiding danger and risks.
<b>Home Energy Basics for CERT Assessors</b> - one-day course covers all the basics required to conduct door to door surveys and criteria for free or discounted energy efficiency grants through CERT (or similar) schemes.
<b>Applying for funding</b> – considerations when looking for funding options for your group
<b>Action Planning for New Groups</b> - identify and develop local opportunities and activities <i>or</i> <b>Action Planning for Existing Groups</b> - keeping the momentum going
<b>Energy Monitors</b> - how to run an energy monitor workshop
<b>Engaging with householders</b> – how to generate interest, facts and figures, how to ‘sell’ the message
<b>How to give a talk</b> – presenting to other groups about energy efficiency and sustainable energy
<b>What’s out there</b> – getting the most out of other initiatives (e.g. GC, Carbon Trust, EST, councils etc...)
<b>Bespoke training</b> as requested by group – depending on CSE resource and preparation time.
<i>Monitoring and evaluation</i>
<b>Questionnaires</b> for measuring change in awareness as a result of a specific activity or to collect baseline info and measure achievements
<b>Interactive carbon pledge</b> PDF document – provides a way to record behaviour change
<b>Links to online resources</b> for monitoring and evaluation
<b>Recommendations</b> for suitable monitoring activities based on identified needs of the group
