

Community Energy Projects in a Box

Draught proofing workshop

Summary

This project in a box guides you through the process of setting up one or more draught proofing workshops in your community. The idea is to invite people along for a demonstration session where you can show different types of draught proofing materials (and how to fit them), discuss what a big difference draught proofing can make, and give away some kit. The aim is to encourage people to go and make improvements in their homes after the workshop and talk to their friends and neighbours about what they have done. The box contains all you'll need to plan, promote, run and evaluate the workshop.

Box contents

- **Guidance:** event running advice; draught proofing instruction manual
- **Resources:** tool bag demonstration kit including samples; draught proofing advice leaflet; PowerPoint presentation (hard copy & electronic copy on USB); posters
- **Promotional materials:** flyer templates
- **Evaluation support:** information for attendees to take away; feedback form for attendees; feedback form for organisers

Outcomes and impact

The aim of the workshop is to inspire members of the community to install draught proofing measures in their own properties, thus saving money on their fuel bills, improving the comfort of their homes and reducing energy use in your community. Taking part in the workshop will mean attendees are much more clued up on what draught proofing options are available, how much they typically cost and how to install them.
